Trainer Stacy Charette-Hill Dominates in Quarter Horse Stakes Races

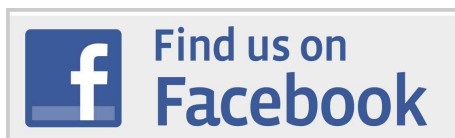

A good size crowd filled the President's suite at Canterbury Park on Saturday, July 13th to learn about horse ownership as presented by TOBA (Thoroughbred Owners & Breeders Association). This event was the third leg of a series of opportunities to learn about many aspects of owning race horses be it Quarter Horse or Thoroughbred. Participants at TOBA seminar received a nice tote bag that was jam-packed with useful items. Included in the contents was a three-ring binder loaded with information to be covered in the seminar.

TOBA representative Andy Schweigardt gave his opening remarks and then introduced a long list of speakers. Peter Ecabert, Counsel and CPA for HBPA spoke on business issues including insurance, accounting, tax and legal issues. There was a horse panel on acquiring a horse that included Jay Dailey of Daily Auction Service; Ted Grevelis, Grevelis Racing Stable, Daily Racing Form writer; Jeff Maday, Media Relations Manager at Canterbury Park.

After a small break, owner Scott Rake and trainer Bernell Rhone spoke on their respective roles. Rhone used a great analogy to describe his role as trainer. "I'm the coach" he said, managing a bunch of athletes on his team. DVM, Richard "Doc" Bowman spoke about his Thoroughbred retirement program and DVM Soctt Kay talked about veterinary topics. A special appearance was presented by Paul Allen, Canterbury Park Track Announcer and Minnesota Vikings Radio Network Voice. Allen talked about how horseracing has presented some great times and memories for he and his family. Susan Martin of Jockey Club Information Systems gave an overview on Equineline.com services and Dr. Jim Chiapetta talked about the FLAIR Nasal Strips. Participants ate lunch, networked with each other and then enjoyed watching and wagering on the races.

The day kicked off with two Quarter Horse races that showcased the explosive start and finish of the track's speedsters. The first race was the Dash in A Flash Stakes, an extremely short race of 110 yards for three year olds. The winner, Stone Cottrell set a new track record at 6.988. The second race was a 220 yard sprint for two year olds. The fans oohed and ahhed as the horses streaked down the track in explosive fashion. Later on in the program, the real extreme racers took center stage. Camels, ostriches, zebras and one Zonkee provided plenty of entertainment and photo opportunities for the Canterbury guests. The day was a memorable one!
