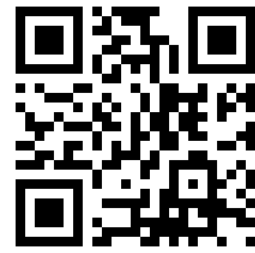

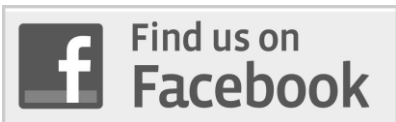

First of 15 Splashed Home on Top in Gopher State Derby, June 9, 2018

The track was muddy and the race was delayed, but that did not stop First of 15 from powering home in a dominating win at on Saturday afternoon in the \$34,150 Gopher State Derby at Canterbury Park.

First of 15 (\$6.20) and jockey Cristian Esqueda defeated runner-up and fastest qualifier Painted Dynasty by two and a half lengths. The final time of the race, 19.751 for 400 yards, was the fastest running of the Gopher State Derby in the 16-year history of the race.

This was the second Gopher State Derby win for trainer Jason Olmstead, but the first for owner Richard Tobin. First of 15 was bred in Oklahoma by James and Marilyn Helzer, out of the Corona Cartel mare Tinys Corona Queen.

The Apollitical Jess filly broke her maiden in her 2-year-old debut at Remington Park. She spent last summer at Canterbury, where she qualified for the \$165,600 Mystic Lake Northlands Futurity and finished third in the \$52,600 NCQHRA Futurity.

She showed improvement as a 3-year-old, qualifying for and finishing second in the \$317,400 Remington Park Oklahoma Bred Derby in April. On the same card, one race earlier, First of 15's full sister, Lynnder 16, with shared connections, won the \$864,500 Remington Park Oklahoma Bred Futurity.

Fastest qualifier Painted Dynasty could never get in front of First of 15 but maintained a steady lead over the rest of the field to defeat third-place finisher Marfilmio by a half-length.

Painted Dynasty won the second of three trials for the Gopher State Derby on May 26 and has finished no worse than second in her three starts as a 3-year-old at both Canterbury and Remington.

Trainer Jason Olmstead completed the exacta with Painted Dynasty's second place finish in the Gopher State. The FDD Dynasty filly was ridden by current leading rider Ry Eikleberry. She is owned by Tom Scheckel and was bred in Oklahoma by Michael Teel, out of the Pyc Paint Your Wagon mare Tygers Painted Girl.

Third-fastest qualifier Marfilmio, with Ismael Suarez Ricardo aboard, completed the trifecta. Marfilmio is a 3-year-old son of Ivory James and is trained by Vic Hanson. Marfilmio competed in allowance races at Remington before returning to Canterbury and winning his trial.

Marfilmio was bred in Texas by Bobby Cox, out of the Mr Jess Perry mare Sinuous. He is owned by David and Debra Harsche.

Completing the field were Cr Lota Girl, Miniscule Monster, Alex Fox Peabody, Waveing At U, Who Rah, Itinkican Itinkican and High Valley Girl.

Bhr Flashing Effrot Upsets Minnesota Stallion Breeders' Futurity, June 3, 2018

In a bit of an upset to start the 2018 Canterbury Park Quarter Horse Stakes season, Bhr Flashing Effort and Chase Clark powered home to win by a head in the \$30,305 Minnesota Stallion Breeders' Futurity.

Bhr Flashing Effort (\$18.20) drew next to heavy favorite and second place finisher Haute Wagon. The pair dueled down the middle of the track right up to the wire in the 350-yard event. Final time for the 31st running of the Minnesota Stallion Breeders' Futurity was 18.466.

Bhr Flashing Effort is trained by Bob Johnson for owners Broken Heart Ranch, who also bred the gray 2-year-old colt in South

Dakota. He is by Cs Flashlight and is out of the Shake It Special mare Bhr Missy Special.

This was Bhr Flashin Effort's second lifetime start; he debuted in Fort Pierre and ran fourth in the South Dakota Bred Futurity.

Haute Wagon and Marcus Swiontek were the bettors' choice heading into the race after a lights out maiden breaking win at Canterbury in May. Prior to that effort, the Wagons West gelding had debuted at Remington Park. Haute Wagon is trained by Vic Hanson for owner and breeder Shelly Berkner. Berkner bred Haute Wagon in Minnesota out of the TimetoGet Tuff mare Chics Timeto Fling.

Third place finisher Just Plain Fast came out of the same Fort Pierre stakes race as Bhr Flashing Effort, but with a sixth place finish. The Hasta Be Fast gelding was ridden by Doug Frink in his Canterbury debut and is also trained by Bob Johnson.

Barbara Jane Tinant owns Just Plain Fast, who was bred by John Johnson in South Dakota, out of the No Brakes Now mare Pass Don't Brake.

Completing the field were Db Quick Sam, Holy Storm, Rckhastabesouthern, The Sizzleizer, Trs Boy Named Sue, Rockem Grace, Eos Tyrone and Knu Ya.

Pyc Jess Bite Mydust Returns to Canterbury's Winner's Circle in the North Star State Stakes, June 3, 2018

The inaugural \$24,000 North Star State Stakes went to one of the most accomplished Minnesota-bred horses in recent history, Pyc Jess Bite Mydust. The 4-year-old gelding made his third start of the year and first start of the 2018 Canterbury Park meet in Sunday's stakes victory, with Cristian Esqueda aboard. Pyc Jess Bite Mydust is trained by Jason Olmstead, two-time winner of Canterbury Park Quarter Horse training title.

Final time for the 300-yard North Star State Stakes was 15.732, resulting in a speed index of 92.

Pyc Jess Bite Mydust is a homebred for Lunderborg LLC, by Apollitical Jess and out of the Pyc Paint Your Wagon mare Paint or More. The gelding was named the Champion Quarter Horse of the Canterbury Park meet in 2016 after winning the open \$165,000 Mystic Lake Northlands Futurity; he returned to win the \$50,000 Minnesota Derby the following year.

Pyc Jess Bite Mydust now has earnings of \$167,641. Eight of his 14 lifetime starts and all four of his career wins have come in Shakopee.

Ralph Haglund completed the trifecta as the owner, breeder and trainer of the second-place finisher Jess a Rumor and third-place finisher Jess a Chance.

Jess a Rumor, with Jake Samuels aboard, threatened to upset the North Star State Stakes after a sharp break and a clean trip. Jess a Rumor and Pyc Jess Bite Mydust put a length and a quarter between them and the rest of the field.

4-year-old Jess a Rumor is by Jess Jones, out of the Ivory James mare Forbidden Ivory.

Jess a Chance and Brayan Velazquez led the rest of the pack and edged out stakes winning mare Blacks Cartel by a head for third place. Jess a Chance is also a 4-year-old son of Jess Jones, out of the First Down Devil mare Unlika Angel.

The North Star State Stakes is restricted to Minnesota-bred 3-year-olds and up and is a new addition to Canterbury's 16-stake race schedule in 2018.

Completing the field were Blacks Cartel, Gramma Ella, Shakemupbayb and Rey D Arranque. Curious James was scratched.

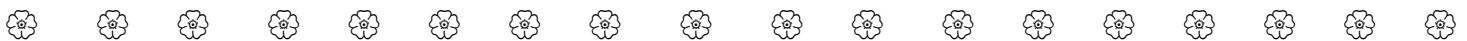
